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



Queenie tried to go back to sleep again, but it was no use. The sound was not going away.


"I am now," snapped Boss, quite crossly. "What is it?"

Queenie took off. She didn't like to run.


Her heart was pounding, but she knew that this was **no time** for complaining!


"You are right!" said Tilly. "They look very small. Why are they with Boss and Queenie?"


Charlie and Maggie looked round the house, just in case something had been left behind.

"It's okay, Charlie," said Maggie. "Remember, your friend Archie just lives around the corner from our old house. When you go to visit him, you will see our old house."


