Some of the activities now require children to find the answers from the text, and write them in the spaces provided.

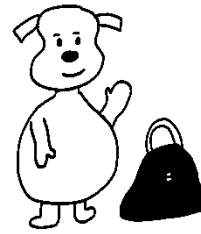
It is important to have a copy of the matching reader on hand, as children complete these activities.
