"Let's Get Your Child Reading"

Thank you for purchasing this publication!

The mastery of high frequency words (sight words) is an important step in teaching young children to read.

Knowledge of high frequency words and phonemic knowledge (sounds and their letter representation/s) work hand in hand in building a child's confidence and importantly, their ability to read.

Using this publication:

Print two copies. Print the first copy back to back and use as booklet. For the second copy, print on one side only, and cut around the table of words and then glue back to back, to create the word on the front side, and the sentence of the back. Cut each individual word to create flashcards.

- Start with one page at a time. Read the word and sentence for your child, then ask them to repeat the word and sentence. Through encouraging your child to point to the words, they begin to learn word-to-word correspondence, and that each group of letters creates a word.
- Tick the words and sentences, each time your child reads them correctly. Young children love to count how many ticks they have!
- As your child masters the words, mix up the order of reading, to ensure that rote learning is not just occurring.
- Once your child knows the first four pages, introduce the flashcards, and mix these up each time you read them. If your child doesn't know the word, flip the card over and encourage them to read the sentence. Always read the word or sentence if your child is unsure.

Most importantly, have fun!!



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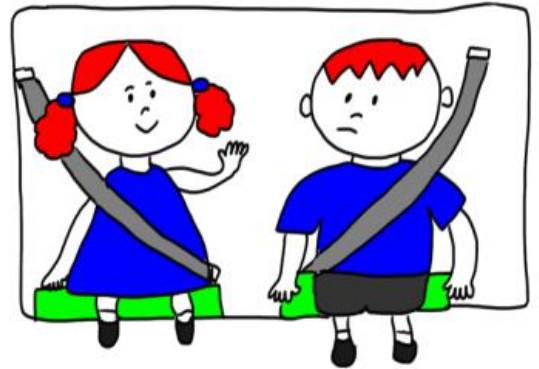
